

Introduction

Welcome to your Natal Chart report.

Uranian astrology

Planetary Aspects to Midpoints

A midpoint is the center between any two points, which in Astrology relates to the center between two planets or other points used in astrology, including the Midheaven, Ascendant, and the Moon's Lunar Nodes. This center point is the meeting of planetary energies that becomes active through the process of growth, relating to the passage of time. We relate to the aspects formed by the heavenly bodies through spatial relationships.

Transneptunian astrology

Also called esoteric astrology are energy spots in space that have orbits around the Sun. They may be an undiscovered planet, asteroids or comets. We are not sure. But their gravitational pull can be felt and they differently impact the astrology chart.

Ascendant

The Ascendant (also known the "rising sign")

The Ascendant is one of the four angles of the chart. The other three are the Descendant (directly opposite the Ascendant), the Imum Coeli (IC), and the Midheaven (MC).

The Ascendant defines, in part, the first impression we make on others in a personal rather than professional sense. It represents our physical appearance, our physical bodies and overall health, and the body ego. The Ascendant is often referred to as the mask we wear, although I don't consider it to be as superficial as this might suggest. What it does represent is our natural and personal defense mechanisms that we use to adapt to, and cope with, our environment.

The Ascendant also shows our first impressions of the world around us, and reveals our expectations of the world around us--whether we are naturally hesitant or enthusiastic, for example. How we begin new projects, and our attitude towards new experiences come under the rule of the Ascendant..

Ascendant in Aquarius

Your primary motivation in life is to have freedom of action and movement. You have a modern, contemporary and progressive outlook on life, with an enthusiasm for the new, the unusual and the innovative. You have an individual and original personality yet, at times, can be unconventional, eccentric or unpredictable. Others are attracted to you

because you are friendly and interested in people. You are accustomed to a lot of change and variety in your day-to-day life.

Ascendant Opposition Sun (5°30' S)

You have a strong desire to become important or to gain the esteem of others. You have a knack for attracting the attention of important and even well-known or famous people. You may tend to overwhelm other people with the power of your personality and display pride or egotism. Difficulties may be experienced in your relations with others caused by arrogance or self-glorification.

Ascendant Opposition Uranus (7°13' A)

You are an original personality and delight in your uniqueness and individuality. You insist on having the freedom to do as you wish, even if it unsettles others. You are a non-conformist and, in all likelihood, ahead of your time. To some people, you are an exciting person to be around; to others you are just too unconventional for them to understand. You need to take care not to come across as too eccentric or weird, because you may isolate yourself socially. You are intrinsically restless and will tend to have many changes of environment throughout the course of your life. You may be a technological whiz.

Ascendant = Saturn/Pluto (-1°54' S)

You have a deeply serious personality. You have adopted a hard-line approach. Taking things to extremes. You have a highly disciplined nature. Fanatical and obsessive tendencies. Contending with restrictive and controlling environments - or people. Taxing relationships and partnerships. Manipulating others - and being manipulated. Decisive separations in life. Significant sacrifices and compromises.

Ascendant = Uranus/Neptune (-1°07' S)

You have an original and idealistic personality. Sensitive and vulnerable to external stimuli. The need to protect and shield oneself from negative environmental influences. Metaphysical interests. You have an experimental nature - taking uncalculated and uncertain risks. You have an intuitive and psychic understanding between partners.

Ascendant = Moon/Jupiter (-0°57' S)

You have a kind and generous nature. Personal contentment and emotional satisfaction. Positive people - and influences - within the environment. Beneficial or affluent connections or family ties. Involvement in social causes or charities; giving to the community. Trust and satisfaction within partnerships. Philosophical or religious interests.

Ascendant = Moon/Mercury (-0°12' S)

You have a perceptive and thoughtful nature; observing the reactions and responses of others. Empathy. Discussing personal feelings with others. Building a strong rapport within partnerships; connecting at an emotional and mental level. Keeping in regular contact with family members. You have alert and receptive to environmental influences.

Ascendant = Neptune/Moon's North Node (-0°06' S)

You have a highly sensitive personality. You have a passive and unassuming manner. Vulnerable and susceptible to environmental influences. Undermining currents within relationships. Misunderstandings or deception within partnerships. You have a risk of betrayal. Connecting with creative and spiritually inclined people.

Ascendant = Neptune/Midheaven (+0°42' A)

You have a self-absorbed personality. Questioning the viability and validity of lifestyle choices. Recycling periods of professional uncertainty and self-doubt. Undermining currents within relationships. Disappointing others and being disappointed. Escapist tendencies. You have addictions and dependencies. Spiritual interests.

Ascendant = Sun/Uranus (+0°51' A d)

You have an original personality - 'one of a kind'. Displaying a willful and assertive manner. Highly independent and demanding. Observing and reacting to environmental situations quickly. Spontaneous interactions and contacts. Stimulating partnerships. Volatile and erratic behavior in self or others. States of restlessness. You have accident prone.

Ascendant = Jupiter/Pluto (+0°52' A)

You have a larger than life personality. Charismatic and magnetic qualities. Being intent on achieving success; powering ahead in life. Large-scale investments and ventures. Influential partnerships. Prominent people within the environment. Social and political activity. You have a risk of over-extending oneself and resources; 'of pushing one's luck'.

Ascendant = Mercury/Pluto (+1°36' A d)

You have a dynamic communicator. Powerful delivery; getting a message across effectively. You have astutely assessing what is taking place within the environment. Dictating to others - or being dictated to. Manipulating people and situations to get what is wanted. You have a domineering personality. Large-scale marketing; media and advertising. Intense discussions; profound realizations and discoveries.

Ascendant = Sun/Moon's North Node (+1°52' A d)

Personal charisma; a confident and vibrant personality. Displaying an authoritative presence. Leading others and taking charge. Important bonds and friendships in life. You have ambitious and influential connections. Healthy and vital partnerships. Organizing activities within the environment. Productive teamwork.

Sun

The Sun

The giver of life, represents our conscious mind in Astrology. It represents our will to live and our creative life force.

Just as the planets revolve around the Sun in our solar system, we derive our life purpose from the Sun in our natal charts. The Sun is our ego. It is also our "adult"-- the part of us that censors our "inner child", that reasons things out, and makes final decisions. The Sun is our basic identity, and represents self-realization. When you are asked, "Who are you?", and you've passed your basic statistics and occupation, your answers will be a description of your Sun. The Sun also represents our overall vitality. The Sun directs us, and can be considered "the boss" of our chart.

With respect to the other luminary (the Moon), the Sun reflects the present or the "here and now", while the Moon infuses the past into our lives through the feelings.

In the chart, the position of the Sun by zodiac sign represents our life purpose and the style in which we leave our mark on the world. By house, the Sun's position shows where our personalities shine. The areas of life associated with that house reveal the types of experiences which contribute to our sense of individuality and which shape our sense of pride. These areas of life are ones in which we seek to express and focus our Sun sign qualities.

Sun in Leo

You are creative in the broadest sense of the word and motivated by the urge to make your mark on the world and to gain a measure of personal recognition and power. You have a desire to be at the center of attention or in the limelight. At your best, you are self-assured, self-confident, out-going, sociable and companionable, but also you can be proud, status-conscious, arrogant and susceptible to flattery. You exude authority and are a natural leader and organizer who can make decisions. You are protective of others and generous by nature.

Sun Square Neptune (3°57' S)

You are highly sensitive and impressionable. You have a tendency to be easily swayed by others; are prone to seducing influences and susceptible to intoxicants and stimulants. While you may be inspired with the best of intentions and ideals, you often lack the power and motivation to bring them to realization. Equally, you may be prone to recycling periods of low vitality and physical weakness. There is a susceptibility to self-deception and seducing influences that can lead to scandals. Your father may be an unknown quantity to you, or even absent. Positively, you may have spiritual inclinations, coupled with a fascination for metaphysical or esoteric subjects. Your inner life is very active, and mystical or psychic experiences are not unfamiliar to you. You have compassion and an ability to feel and understand the needs of others with sympathy and empathy. You may be gifted with a measure of inspiration and creativity, which may express itself through the arts - especially music, painting, photography or drama.

Sun = Saturn/Moon's North Node (-1°14' S)

You have a solitary disposition. Inclination to stand apart or in isolation. Reclusive tendencies. Difficulty integrating with others. Expressing or experiencing negative attitudes in company. Taking on positions of responsibility in the community or family. Earning the respect of other people. Contacts with serious and experienced people. Estrangements and separations.

Sun = Saturn/Midheaven (-0°26' A)

Development of self-reliance. You have a strong sense of purpose and direction in life. Motivation to establish and secure a position in life. Gaining respect and authority through hard work and discipline. Difficulties in career or vocation. Tendency to be readily discouraged or prone to defeatist attitudes. Contending with inhibitions of an inner or external nature. Limiting professional and domestic or family circumstances.

Sun = Venus/Mars (-0°22' S d)

Power of attraction. Sexual magnetism. Sensuality. Passionate nature. You are a ardent in love. Strong desire for sexual experiences and physical and emotional unions. Lust. You have adventures in love. The urge to become a parent. Creative flair - artistic skill or appreciation.

Sun = Jupiter/Uranus (+0°31' A)

You have an adventurous and optimistic spirit. You have a contemporary outlook. You have an innovative and original mind. You have an eagerness for new and stimulating

experiences. Resourceful and mentally flexible. Sudden opportunities and successes. You have applying new ideas and techniques successfully. Intuitiveness. Progressive leadership.

Sun = Neptune/Ascendant (+0°47' S)

Physical sensitivity. Susceptibility to environmental influences. The tendency to yield - or go with the flow. You have an impressionable and receptive personality. The state of feeling vulnerable or easily embarrassed. You have a risk of being undermined or victimized by others.

Sun = Mercury/Uranus (+1°15' S d)

Original and intuitive thinking. You have a quick learner with the ability to sum up situations quickly. Intellectual flexibility. Mentally alert and astute. Thinking outside of the box. You have an interest in reforms and innovations. Open to new and progressive ideas or methods. Restless. Easily distracted. Impulsive and contradictory. Nervous energy.

Sun = Jupiter/Moon's North Node (+1°32' A)

Ease of self-expression in the company of others. Capability to readily integrate and to be a vital member of a group or association. You have alliances which further personal objectives. You have advantageous and pro-active connections. Contact with achievers. Fortunate partnerships. Intellectual associations. You have academic, philosophical and foreign contacts.

Sun = Moon/Saturn (+1°48' S)

Self-reliant and self-sufficient. Feelings of isolation or standing alone in life. Necessity to take responsibility for self and actions. Testing personal and family circumstances. Emotional or physical separations. Recycling periods of low self-confidence or self-motivation.

Moon

The Moon Represents our deepest personal needs, our basic habits and reactions, and our unconscious.

Where the Sun acts, the Moon reacts. How do we instinctively react or respond to problems? What do we feel we need for a sense of security? Look to the Moon in your natal chart for answers. The Moon is associated with the mother and with feminine energy in general. The Moon is both our inner child and our inner

mother. It is responsive, receptive, and reflective. The Moon is our spontaneous and instinctual reactions.

Just as the Moon circles the Sun, in a symbolically protective manner, and reflects the Sun's light, the Moon in our chart shows how we protect ourselves, as well as make ourselves feel secure, comfortable, and safe. For some of us, our Moons seem to drive our personalities more than the Sun does. This is particularly true if the Moon is in a water sign (Cancer, Scorpio, or Pisces), or if it is conjunct an angle in the chart (near the Ascendant, Descendant, 4th house cusp, or 10th house cusp). For true happiness in life, it is wise to neither give your Moon too much nor too little importance in your life.

"When you "know what you mean but you can't say it," it is your Moon that knows it and your Sun that can't say it. "Thoughts that do often lie too deep for tears" are the thoughts of your Moon's nature. The wordless ecstasy, the mute sorrow, the secret dream, the esoteric picture of yourself that you can't get across to the world, or which the world doesn't comprehend or value - these are the products of the Moon in your horoscope.

With respect to the other luminary (the Sun), the Moon infuses the past into our lives through the feelings, while the Sun reflects the present or the "here and now". When expressing our Moon, we are imaginative, creative, intuitive, sentimental, adaptable, introspective, and protective. On the negative side, we can be moody, restless, and irrational.

In the natal chart, the position of the Moon by sign shows how we emote and respond to our environment, as well as our instinctual habits, especially in our homes and in private. By house, the Moon's position shows which areas of life we feel the most "at home" or comfortable.

Moon in Gemini

You have a strong need to communicate your feelings. It is possible that you will rationalize your feelings or allow your intellect to control your emotional life. Your home-life is usually stimulating and often a center for learning and lively discussion.

Moon in 4th House

Your home is vitally important to your feeling of emotional well-being. You need the establishment of a safe and secure home and family-life and will probably spend a lot of time in your home generally. You identify strongly with your family history and place of birth - even if you move away from the family or birthplace in later life. You can tend to play the parental role within domestic environments, by caring for and protecting those you live with.

With the Moon in 4th House your feeling, instinctive nature will find expression mainly through your family and home environment. Your day-to-day response to circumstance is strongly conditioned by family relationships and domestic issues. To feel emotionally secure you need a meaningful and secure home life.

Moon Sextile Mercury (1°02' S)

Your thoughts are influenced by your feelings and vice versa. You are highly perceptive and can easily sense the moods and feelings of others. Your mind is both fertile and imaginative and hungry for knowledge. You are an instinctual student and teacher, whose understanding of a subject is emotionally based. Articulate and able to impart knowledge effortlessly, you have a good memory and may be a good storyteller.

Moon Trine Jupiter (2°30' S)

You are naturally generous, open-minded and kind-hearted. Your emotional honesty and good humor make you popular and appreciated by others. You are socially aware and always ready to help other people. You are interested in philosophy and religion, and, if other factors in your chart support it, you will have the opportunity to travel. You know how to enjoy yourself and are fond of sociable and pleasurable activities. Relations with women are usually positive.

Moon Square Pluto (3°37' A)

You have a complex emotional life. Your feelings are intense and you feel things deeply. The dynamics of your personal relationships are intricate and often strained, especially with your family or significant females. There are power struggles in the home or with dominant women. Equally, you can be domineering or emotionally manipulative and intent on getting everything your own way. You can also be prone to particular habitual fixations or compulsions.

Moon Opposition Midheaven (4°28' A)

Your highest aspirations are soul based and spiritually significant to you. You have the power to form supportive contacts in your vocation, especially with women. However, your career path is likely to be affected by work demands and family commitments encroaching upon one another.

Moon Square Chiron (1°58' A)

You are a suffering and wounded person. You feel that you are misunderstood, particularly by your own mother. Once you have learnt to rise above your pain, you will have the ability to understand and help others.

Moon = Mercury/Venus (-1°18' S)

You have an affectionate and caring nature; attentive and sensitive to the needs of others. You have a talent for art, language and writing. Being drawn to that which appeals to the eye, senses and emotions. The need to be involved in creative expression and dialogues. Discussing intimate relationship details with others. You have a creative family. Hospitable and entertaining. Social awareness.

Moon = Pluto/Moon's North Node (-1°13' S)

Profound emotional experiences. Intensity of feeling in relationships. Power struggles in partnerships and within family dynamics. Manipulation and control. Subjection to family and cultural pressures. Participating in public or mass gatherings. Influential and domineering women.

Moon = Sun/Mars (-0°48' S)

You have a self-motivated individual who gets results. You have acting as a protector and provider - hard working and productive. You have a dominant figure in domestic, family and relationship affairs. Taking care of others and taking charge of situations. Marriage and procreation. Emotional reactions to conflict, aggressive energy or pushiness.

Moon = Pluto/Midheaven (-0°25' A)

Commitment to personal and professional aspirations; feeling compelled to follow a particular path in life. Extreme ambition. You have attaining powerful or authoritative positions. Specialized interests and projects. You have a destiny shaped by family and cultural influences. Contending with vocational pressure or resentment. Potential power struggles. Intense emotional reactions or responses.

Moon = Venus/Neptune (+1°50' A)

Emotional sensitivity. You have a soft-hearted and sentimental nature. You have a giving, supportive and loving person. The need to care for others and to feel cared for. Enjoying and being emotionally uplifted by beauty, art and music. Romantic idealism. Wishful and hopeful in love. Sexual infatuations. Relationship disappointments. The potential for deceiving others - and being deceived.

Midheaven

The Midheaven It is found at the very top of the chart, and it is the most public point in our chart. It relates to our career or "life path" and suggests our social standing and reputation.

The Midheaven is one of the four angles of the chart. The other three are the Imum Coeli (IC - directly opposite the Midheaven), the Ascendant (ASC), and the Descendant (DSC).

The Midheaven represents our most visible achievements in the eyes of society, our public "face" (as opposed to our more personal "face" at the Ascendant), our accomplishments, and our overall sense of responsibility and standing in the world/society..

Midheaven in Scorpio

Self-realization is achieved through overcoming desire and managing power. Your aim in life is to unlock the secrets of nature. You attain your objectives through tenacity, perseverance and determination. You have abilities for research and investigative work.

Midheaven Trine Mercury (3°26' A)

You are able to maintain a good balance between your professional life and your home life. Most likely, you will receive good vocational guidance and a sound education from your parents. You are interested in learning and study; and intellectual work should be quite easy for you. You are a good conversationalist and other people seek you out to hear your opinions. You keep yourself informed and up to date with developments in the world and your career.

Midheaven Quincunx Venus (2°54' A)

You are a warm-hearted and loving individual and, in general, enjoy good relationships with your family and work colleagues. You have a unique sense of style and have quite individualistic fashion tastes and preferences. Status in your career is important to you, and vocational successes are likely in creative occupations or the arts, the beauty or fashion industries, or the public relations sectors. You have high expectations in love and, at some point in your life, will experience a love union that all others are measured by. Negatively, you can turn others off through laziness, narcissism or conceit. There may be disharmony with others caused by family and vocational demands impinging upon one another.

Midheaven Sextile Jupiter (1°58' A)

This aspect can help you to rise to high positions in your career. You have the desire to do well in life and to advance personally and professionally. Others may seek you out for your advice and those in power tend to favor you. You may do well in areas related to spirituality, publishing, travel, law or education.

Midheaven Square Uranus (3°37' S)

You march to the beat of your own drum. Others see you as a unique personality who is strongly individualistic. You assert your right to be independent and original. Professionally, you will choose a career that is unusual in some way, or you could be attracted to modern occupations, involving the latest technological or scientific advancements. One word of warning, this aspect can sometimes cause reckless behavior, which can lead to sudden reversals of fortune or falls from grace. Your domestic circumstances are often changeable or unstable.

Midheaven Square Moon's North Node (1°35' S)

The best friends you can make in life are with people who share the same aims and aspirations as you do. You have a strong need to be with people who understand and appreciate you at an inner level. You may be quite status conscious. Family ties are significant. There can be problems with the career.

Midheaven = Mercury/Mars (-1°26' S)

You have a decisive individual. Demonstrating the power of intent particularly with regard to vocational aspirations. Knowing how to achieve personal and professional ambitions. You have assessing situations quickly. You have a talent for organization and delegation. You have a clear and succinct communicator. Debating skills. Moments of impatience and intolerance.

Midheaven = Pluto/Ascendant (-1°23' S d)

You have a charismatic individual. You have a passionate and dedicated nature; commitment to specific goals and aspirations. You have attaining influential and powerful positions in personal and professional life - an expert or leader in specialized fields. Understanding the pros and cons of power. Potential power struggles. Obsessive tendencies. Contending with resentment and jealousy.

Midheaven = Venus/Saturn (-0°20' S)

Difficult and testing experiences in love. Sexual restraint. You have a fear of commitment - in self or another. The desire to control a loved one - or likewise being controlled. Inner and emotional dissatisfaction - withdrawing from another or a lover. Separative influences. Renunciation - unrequited love. Professional worries and anxieties.

Midheaven = Moon/Uranus (+0°25' A)

You have a volatile emotional life - highly excitable and reactive tendencies. You have asserting the will to go one's own way - personally and professionally. Independent initiatives and aspirations. Intuitively ascertaining future trends. Sudden change in professional direction. Unpredictability within domestic and work environments.

Midheaven = Mars/Neptune (+1°42' A)

You have a despondent nature; giving up hope or belief easily. Waning enthusiasm and motivation. Difficulty sustaining a course of action. The tendency to become distracted - submissive and passive. Vocational insecurity. Undermining currents within profession. Indifference about one's career. Evasive and escapist tendencies. Idealistic aspirations. Pursuing a spiritual path.

Mercury

Mercury The messenger of the gods, It is the planet of day to day expression and communication. Mercury's action is to take things apart and put them back together again. It is an opportunistic planet, decidedly unemotional and curious.

In modern times, we tend to "meet" people's Mercury first. Many people make a connection for the first time through e-mails, for example. Mercury rules whether we are flowery in our speech or written words, concise in our choice of words, or business-like even in our personal communications. Mercury not only rules communication, it represents coordination. Thought processes, ideas, and sensory information from both unconscious and conscious sources all need to be coordinated and understood. Mercury analyzes, sorts, groups, and makes sense of things. How do we handle nervous energy? How do we express and convey our thoughts? How do we approach others and information in order to learn and exchange ideas?

When expressing our Mercury energy, we are inquisitive, curious, communicative, and versatile. On the negative side, we can be high-strung or nervous, nit-picky, indecisive, and overly technical.

On a personal level, look to Mercury in the chart to reveal how you get your point across, how do you study, and how you process information. Mercury by sign shows an individual's style of communication. By house, Mercury reveals where natives seek to have a voice as well as which areas of life they tend to intellectualize and give a lot of thought to. Mercury colors the planets it aspects with a desire for communication and exchange of information. Similarly, the planets Mercury aspects affect the way an individual communicates. Mercury prominent in a chart points to wit, liveliness, and curiosity.

Mercury in Leo

You are a self-assured communicator and a strong-minded person with firm convictions and fixed opinions. As you are expressive and forceful in your manner of

communicating, people will follow your lead. As a rule, you prefer to look at the overall picture. A mass of facts and figures is likely to bog you down and stifle your creativity.

Mercury in 6th House

Your thinking is primarily focused on work matters and employment. You are motivated by the urge to acquire specialized skills and expertise in specific fields and you recognize the need to keep up to date with technological advances and new developments in your profession. You are a hard worker; however you need to pace yourself well, in order to avoid stress-related illnesses. You may work in office environments, the health sector, computing, the service industries or research. You are generally interested in health matters, diet and hygiene.

Your mental and communicative abilities will largely be applied to acquiring specialised skills or knowledge for professional use. Your work may demand an intellectual quality of mind, analytical ability and strict attention to detail. There is a concern for personal health, hygiene, tidiness, correct dress and polite speech. You may find success in fields such as science, teaching or administration.

Mercury Opposition Jupiter (1°28' S)

You are basically an optimist at heart and usually express a positive and confident outlook on life. In your desire to broaden your knowledge, you will most likely travel, correspond with people in other countries and possibly study or have business arrangements overseas. You may be well read and erudite. Certainly, you appreciate the value and benefits of a sound education. Possibly, you may have a tendency to be absent-minded, or inclined to overlook important details. Poor judgment or sloppy thinking can lead to problems with investments, contracts or legal documents. At times, you may be intellectually arrogant, preachy or prone to exaggeration.

Mercury Quincunx Chiron (2°59' A)

You find it difficult to grasp some concepts having to do with non-ordinary healing methods and unconventional experiences of time and the nature of reality. You may have very expanded perceptions and sense the validity of the mind/body connection as well as the mind's ability to manipulate time and effect healing, but attempts to clearly understand and communicate these ideas elude you. There is much opportunity to grow in awareness through this effort, but it will require frequent adjustments of your definitions of reality.

Mercury Quintile Ceres (0°04' A)

You have a gift for communicating in a supportive and nurturing manner. This talent will create opportunities to assist others in understanding their experiences of separation or

loss. You could be an excellent counselor, especially in relation to parent/child relationships and issues of attachment and letting go. You have an innate understanding of these dynamics, and an original and sometimes dramatic way of expressing your understanding which is very effective.

Mercury Trine Juno (1°40' S)

You communicate well within relationships and this is the cornerstone of your success in marriage. Agreements, expectations and social roles are openly discussed, making your daily interaction an easy, natural flow. You may be a model for others in this regard.

Mercury = Saturn/Neptune (-0°22' S)

Focusing on the inner aspect of life. Spiritual disciplines and insights. Meditation; stilling the mind. Knowing what is required to make dreams and wishes a reality; understanding the necessity for sacrifices. Ideas and ideals that need to be tempered and grounded. You have a proneness to self-doubt and defeatist attitudes. Unfounded anxiety; imagining things are worse than they really are. Debilitating pessimism.

Mercury = Moon/Venus (+0°15' S)

Intellectual receptivity and creativity. You have an instinctive visual and aesthetic sense. Feeling blessed and acknowledging it. You have affectionate responses. Pondering the nature of love. Discussing intimate feelings with others. Talking about relationship and sexual needs and desires; speaking with heart and soul. Thinking about parenthood. Communication with women and family members.

Mercury = Sun/Saturn (+1°36' A)

You have a disciplined mind. You have applying self to serious study and research. Concentration and focus. Logic and reason. Succinct in speech and writing. Single-minded. The tendency to view life seriously and realistically. You have a practical philosopher. You have a slow accomplishment of goals. Perseverance. You have a risk of health problems through poor dietary habits and neglect. Shyness and reticence. Skepticism. You have a negative outlook. Sober and somber realizations. Mental blocks.

Venus

Venus The Goddess of Love and Beauty. Venus represents two main areas of our life: love and money.

"Love and money" is actually a simplistic interpretation of Venus. Venus rules our sentiments, what we value, and the pleasure we take in life. Grace, charm, and beauty are all ruled by Venus. Through Venus, we learn about our tastes, pleasures, artistic inclinations, and what makes us happy.

We look to Venus in the natal chart to see how we approach relationships of the heart, as well as what gives us pleasure. Do we enjoy the give and take of relationships (Venus in Libra), the security our relationships give us (Venus in Cancer), or the thrill of the conquest (Venus in Aries)? Its placement in the houses of the natal chart reveal which areas of life we seek to balance, refine, and derive pleasure from. Do we take particular pleasure in our day-to-day work and routines (Venus in the 6th house), in study and travel (Venus in the 9th house), or in taking care of our house and home (Venus in the 4th house)?

We also turn to Venus to show how we spend our money, the types of gifts we buy, and how much we spend on leisure activities (not to mention the kinds of leisure activities we seek out).

Venus rules attachments to others. It rules attractiveness--both the ability to attract and attraction to others (and things). Venus energy is harmonious, and this is why people with Venus prominent in their charts are often peace-makers. In Venus, we find a need to be appreciated and to appreciate. Venus rules, amongst other things, the arts, love and romance, beauty and the beautifying process, money, entertainment, leisure, sensuality, and comfort.

When expressing Venus energy, we compromise, make peace, are loving, and act with taste. On the negative side, we can be self-indulgent, self-centered, vain, and superficial.

Venus in Cancer

You experience deep and sincere feelings of love and are caring and protective towards your loved ones. To feel emotionally secure, you need to have affection and tenderness demonstrated. You are sensitive in love and hopelessly romantic, but can easily be hurt by insensitivity from another. You have a desire for partnership and an appreciation of family-life. Social activities are often centered in the home and your guests always feel welcome.

Venus in 5th House

You have a strongly romantic nature and will probably experience many affairs of the heart. You know how to live and how to enjoy life's pleasures. You are easy-going, popular and well-liked. Other people are attracted to you for your infectious sense of

fun. Children, in particular, find you easy to get along with. You appreciate the arts, and are probably artistically talented in some form of creative expression, especially acting, dancing, music or singing.

With Venus in 5th House the areas of life where you are most likely to express your social, romantic and artistic qualities are through a genuine love of life, especially in romantic attachments, hobbies, personal pleasures and social interests. Your infectious love of life and noble nature ensures socially popularity, although, at times, you can be rather theatrical in order to hog the spotlight. You usually choose a partner you can show-off with, and proudly display to friends and colleges. Appreciation of the arts is indicated. There is some predisposition to gambling or other forms of financial speculation. Children will be a very important factor in your life.

Venus Quincunx Jupiter (0°56' S)

Even the 'difficult' aspects, such as this, between Venus and Jupiter are not as challenging as other planetary combinations. They are, after all, the so-called benefic planets and they tend to work well together. At worst, there can be a tendency towards negligence and laziness, or over-indulgence and wastefulness. To some extent, life's advantages can come too easily to you, resulting in a tendency to take things for granted. Still, this is a very desirable aspect to have in your chart because it brings social and worldly benefits and facilitates successful relationships with others. Romantic encounters are generally positive and happy, and artistic ability is evident. Positively, you have a pleasant and affectionate nature, which warms people to you easily. Gregarious and optimistic, you embrace life wholeheartedly and fully. You have an attractive personality and a kind-hearted manner about you, with the ability to gain popularity or favoritism from others.

Venus Trine Chiron (3°32' A)

You have a natural affinity for and understanding of the mind/body connection, non-traditional healing arts and non-ordinary spiritual experiences. You might be regarded as a maverick because you accept no dogmas, but pursue truth in your own way. You are adept at expressing these concepts in artistic and aesthetic ways, making them more palatable and accessible to others. You discover many keys through your own healing journey, which you effectively express for the benefit of all.

Venus Square Juno (1°08' S)

There is some dilemma or conflict around the issues of harmony and pleasure versus the ideals of intimacy and equality in committed relationship. Possibly marriage becomes an obstacle to true love, or perhaps you and your partner have difficulty understanding each other's expression (or lack thereof) of affection.

Venus Sextile Zeus (1°28' A)

You are able to apply your mind to most activities in your life. You have a serious approach to learning.

Venus = Jupiter/Midheaven (-1°55' S d)

Embracing life whole-heartedly. You have appreciating what life has to offer. Good fortune in love and partnership. Opportunities to advance personal aspirations and desires. Prospering materially and socially. You have attaining status, artistic recognition or professional success. Satisfying personal desires. Expensive and extravagant tastes.

Venus = Sun/Ascendant (-1°29' A)

You have a pleasant and vibrant personality. Sex-appeal; personal charm and allure. Well-mannered and courteous. Self-confidence - being admired and respected by others. Physical and emotional intimacy between partners. Sincere and loving relationships. You have a personal sense of style and fashion. Creative talent or appreciation.

Venus = Mercury/Midheaven (-1°11' A)

You have attractive and appealing qualities. Knowing how to enjoy life and to live for the moment. Contemplating the meaning of love. You have acknowledging the true value of something or someone. You have analyzing and discussing intimate relationships; the desire to talk things through with another. Heart-felt aspirations. Recognizing the benefits of having clearly defined aims in life. Professional satisfaction; favorable career moves. You have artistic appreciation. You have a studied art or developed talent.

Venus = Saturn/Pluto (-0°38' S)

You have appreciating simplicity; leading a spartan existence. Understated displays of affection. Triumphs and knock-backs in love - and in life. Loyalty and commitment within partnerships. Difficulties through a lack of tolerance and compromise. Repressed emotional and sexual desires. Contending with extreme pressure within relationships. Controlling others or being controlled. You have a decisive separation.

Venus = Uranus/Neptune (+0°09' A)

Sudden changes of heart. The tendency to be carried away by romantic notions and wishes; a person who is easily influenced and swayed emotionally and sexually. Confusion and disorientation. You have a chaotic love and sex life. Disappointment and instability within love and partnership. Creative vision. Sudden artistic inspiration. Enjoying alternative or progressive art forms.

Venus = Moon/Jupiter (+0°19' S)

You have a loving, supportive and generous nature. Finding emotional happiness with another. Harmonious and successful relationships. Family, social and material benefits. The desire for emotional and financial security. Personal satisfaction and contentment. You have artistic appreciation and talent; creative and enterprising. Productive and fertile activity. Extravagance and indulgence.

Venus = Moon/Mercury (+1°03' S d)

Feeling young at heart. You have a caring and giving nature. You have attentive and perceptive; sensitive to the thoughts and wishes of others. Knowing what pleases people. Discussing intimate feelings. Love dialogues and conversations. You have artistic talent and appreciation. Beauty and refinement. Social connections and contacts.

Venus = Neptune/Moon's North Node (+1°10' A)

Idealistic expectations in love and partnership. Emotional sensitivity and empathy within relationships. Sentimentality. Romantic notions about love unions. Infatuations; idolizing others. Feeling at ease in the company of creative and artistic people. Spiritual connections. Misdirected passions. Deceiving another or being deceived by loved ones. Partnership disappointments.

Mars

Mars Rules our animal instincts for aggression, anger, and survival. Our sexual desires come under the rule of Mars. Whereas Venus rules romantic attraction, Mars is most associated with basic body attraction. This is the planet of action rather than reaction. With Mars, there is no contemplation before action. The drive associated with Mars differs from that of the Sun in that it is self-assertion rather than assertion of the will; it is raw energy rather than creative energy. Mars is the push that gets us out of bed in the morning, our drive and desire nature, and our active energy. When we are "acting out" our Mars, we are assertive, directed, forthright, and adventurous. On the negative side, we can be impulsive, rash, impatient, aggressive, and forceful.

In the chart, the position of Mars by sign shows our basic sexual nature, how we express our anger (our temper), what makes us angry, and our first instinct to act. Our competitive nature is revealed in the nature of Mars' sign. By house, the position of Mars shows the areas of life where we apply our drive and express our

enthusiasm. Planets that Mars contacts are colored with action and self-assertion. These planets can represent the kinds of experiences we seek..

Mars in Virgo

Your goals and actions are usually practical and useful. You are economical in the expenditure of energy. Precise and exacting, you are motivated to do the best you can at any task. You approach projects in a logical and methodical manner. You are intolerant of sloppiness and untidiness in the work environment. You tend to get angry or irritable when routines are upset or things don't go to plan. Conflicts are possible with work colleagues.

Mars in 7th House

You are drawn to active, energetic and enthusiastic people. You like to take part in team activities or projects together with a partner. Direct and competitive in your relationships, you need a partner that you can spar with. Quarrels and disagreements are frequent in your personal unions. Other people can annoy or irritate you if you interfere in your life, or insist on organizing you against your will. You are outgoing and sociable and tend to make and break contacts quickly and impulsively.

With Mars in the Seventh House you are likely to exert your energy and initiative in active co-operation with others as associates or in partnerships of some kind. You can be aggressive and forceful in intimate relationships, or you may marry someone with this natural temperament. An early marriage is possible and your energy and passion will ensure a happy, demonstrative and rewarding sex-life. You are likely to gain popularity, social success, money or property through your marriage partner. With this placing of Mars it is important to be restrained in all dealings with associates, business partners and the opposite sex. If your aggressive nature becomes dominant there is danger of trouble and loss through public opposition, unpopularity, damaged relationships, female enmity or litigation.

Mars Trine Saturn (2°45' A)

You are a hard worker and have the power to realize your objectives through perseverance and determination. You are good at physical and manual work, or activities requiring self-discipline and stamina such as endurance sports. In stressful or dangerous situations, you can be counted on to keep a clear and cool head.

Mars Trine Ceres (2°11' S)

You are very good at nurturing self-confidence and independence. You know how to give support and encouragement without usurping control. You may be a role model or teacher for others in the art of parent-child relations. Knowing when to give comfort and support, and when to let go and foster self-determination is instinctive for you. You tend

to be very involved with your offspring, and can be fiercely protective when the occasion arises.

Mars Opposition Pallas (1°49' A)

You may avoid involvement in socially active groups even though you support their causes, because you resist being a "joiner". You tend to prefer going it alone, yet you recognize the need for organized action. Your own ambitions and self-interest may seem to preclude fighting for the cause of justice, or you may simply lack the self-confidence to take an active role. There might be conflict over gender roles, and gender equality may be an important issue in your life, yet you may feel reluctant to take a firm stand for what you believe in or know is right. These issues are likely to be acted out within the context of a close relationship.

Mars Trine Vesta (2°28' A)

You are drawn to the role of spiritual warrior, and are capable of exerting great effort and sacrificing personal safety and comfort for the sake of a sacred or cherished purpose. Your path may be one of martial arts or include intense competition and strenuous activity. Courage and assertiveness are very much a part of your style, you are dynamic and forceful, and welcome challenges.

Mars = Saturn/Ascendant (-0°53' A)

You have a guarded personality. You have active defiance. Confronting issues as they arise. Fighting against negative and depressive influences. The state of being directly at odds with others in the environment. The desire to overcome shyness and inhibition. Difficulty taking action and asserting self. Suppressed frustration and anger. Tension within partnerships. Decisive separations.

Mars = Sun/Jupiter (-0°52' S)

Pursuing personal objectives with self-confidence and enthusiasm. Successful personal ventures and realized ambitions. You have accomplishing goals by taking decisive and affirmative action. High degrees of self-motivation and initiative. Productivity. Self-promotion and personal advancement. You have an active social life. Contacts with prominent people. Business activity.

Mars = Sun/Mercury (-0°08' A)

Intellectually sharp and clever. Planning and pursuing clear objectives. Tactical skill in competitive situations - thriving on challenge. You have asserting personal view points. Jumping to conclusions. Recognizing danger and knowing how and when to act. Impulsive thoughts and actions. Verbally aggressive and argumentative. Retaliation. You have accidents through a lack of concentration. Quick actions and reactions.

Mars = Jupiter/Ascendant (+1°53' S)

You have a competent and well-organized person. The desire to be respected and recognized for achievements. You have a confident and exuberant personality. Good natured and good humored. You have a generous nature. Philanthropy. Enthusiasm between partners. Establishing successful business and social relationships. Profitable connections.

Jupiter

Jupiter The planet of plenty. "Opportunity knocks at every door," It is tolerant and expansive. Jupiter seeks insight through knowledge.

Jupiter is associated with good luck and bounty. Optimism and growth (including mental and spiritual growth). On the up side, Jupiter is associated with a sense of humor, good will, and mercy. The more negative manifestations of Jupiter include blind optimism, excess, and overindulgence. Irresponsibility that results from blind optimism, not ill will, can be displayed.

In the chart, the position of Jupiter by sign reveals how we express our generosity and tolerance. It shows how we go about trusting others and improving our lives. Where do we look for wisdom and understanding? Look to Jupiter's position by house and to the planets it contacts for answers..

Jupiter in Aquarius

You have an impartial and unprejudiced nature, with a strong social sense. You have humanitarian tendencies and can be tolerant and accepting of the viewpoints of others, even if you don't agree with them. Equally, you can be provocative and revolutionary in your thinking, especially in regard to social or humanitarian issues.

Jupiter in 12th House

You have a humble and somewhat sacrificing nature and enjoy being of service to those in need. You may involve yourself with charity or volunteer work. Successes are possible through involvement with large institutions such as hospitals, universities or churches. Periods of solitude and seclusion from others can rejuvenate you.

With Jupiter in the Twelfth House you will find luck, ease of working and general good fortune coming through spiritual work, literature, art, poetry, religion or stage and screen work. Inspiration, support and guidance may come from an inner search for spiritual fulfillment - in the form of meditation, seclusion and introspective study. At some stage of life you may make a great personal sacrifice in order to fulfill your ideal of worthwhile service, perhaps through asylums, hospitals or public institutions. There is likely to be an interest in medicine, chemistry, healing and metaphysical or occult studies - you have a healthy respect for ancient wisdom and the more profound teachings.

Jupiter Conjunct Saturn (5°32' A)

In general, your life alternates between periods of optimism and pessimism and periods of financial abundance and financial hardship. It can sometimes seem that everything good that happens to you comes at a cost. Your challenge is to find the middle path between enjoying life and keeping it real. Occasionally, you experience feelings of dissatisfaction with your lot in life; however this can serve as a motivation to improve your situation. All of your personal successes - academic, financial or emotional - are hard won and gained through industry, perseverance and self-discipline. You have a good head for business because you understand the cycles of expansion and consolidation. Your philosophical outlooks tend to be orthodox and conservative.

Jupiter BiQuintile Pluto (0°07' S)

You might be drawn to the occult; shamanism, hypnotism or mediumship. In whatever your chosen role, you have a gift for inspiring confidence and trust, and for creatively and dynamically leading people to uncover their most sensitive secrets and reclaim their own power. Your methods are exciting, dramatic and original.

Jupiter Quincunx Moon's North Node (3°33' A)

You are generally successful in your dealings with people, as you have the ability to adapt to their needs. You will make many contacts in life and, in most cases, your personal relationships and partnerships should be harmonious and positive. However, difficulties with others are possible because of a lack of adaptability or philosophical differences.

Jupiter Trine Vesta (5°49' A)

You have a wonderful capacity for faith and optimism that can see you through life's challenges with a commendable attitude. You can make personal sacrifice for your beliefs without feeling deprived or self-righteous.

Jupiter = Venus/Moon's North Node (-1°19' A d)

Enjoying social interactions. Successfully gaining the affection of others. Feeling at ease in the company of other people. Giving and receiving within relationships; beneficial ties. Valuing and appreciating intimate connections. Trust and intimacy within love partnerships. Moving in artistic circles. Celebrations within the family.

Jupiter = Mars/Pluto (-1°05' A)

The power of intent and accomplishment. Directing energies into expansion, development and improvement. Large-scale and long term projects. Material and financial investments. Taking effective measures to ensure success. Covering all bases. Relentless drive and determination. Fanaticism. Productive and resourceful. The potential for significant achievements.

Jupiter = Venus/Midheaven (-0°31' A)

You have a positive self-image. You have a high social profile; status conscious. You have affluent ties and connections. Influential and beneficial social contacts. You have advancing in life through the support and generosity of others. Style conscious. Professional success in the entertainment, beauty and fashion industries. You have a fulfilling love union. Prosperity.

Jupiter = Saturn/Neptune (+1°07' S)

Heightened physical and emotional sensitivity. Easily overwhelmed; susceptible to exhaustion and bouts of low of vitality. The gradual undermining of general health and well-being. Fluctuating levels of optimism. Benefits from periodic solitude. Meditation - spiritual retreat. Faith and devotion. Willingly making sacrifices for others. Religiosity and asceticism.

Jupiter = Moon/Venus (+1°43' S)

You have a warm-hearted and generous soul. Emotional and physical well-being. Giving and receiving. Enjoying life and all its pleasures - material comforts. Happiness and prosperity in love and partnership. Fulfilled expectations in emotional and family life. Fertility. Nurturing and protective instincts; rewarding parenting. Successful creative ventures. Self-indulgence.

Saturn

Saturn is associated with restriction and limitation.

Where Jupiter expands, Saturn constricts. Although the themes of Saturn seem depressing, Saturn brings structure and meaning to our world. Saturn knows the limits of time and matter. Saturn reminds us of our boundaries, our responsibilities, and our commitments. It brings definition to our lives. Saturn makes us aware of the need for self-control and of boundaries and our limits.

Saturn is often associated with our fathers or father/authority figures. In childhood, the discipline, rules, and regulations imposed on us by our authority figures--from parents, teachers, and the like--were not always pleasant, but they actually helped us to understand the world around us. Similarly, Saturn's lessons actually help us to grow.

In the chart, the position of Saturn by sign and house reveals our own limitations, fears, and sense of responsibility. Saturn brings definition, and often limitation, to the planets it aspects.

Saturn in Capricorn

Your will is strong and unyielding. Ambitious for power, status and authority, you tend to measure your self-worth through how satisfied you are with your personal achievements. You are self-disciplined, practical, frugal and aware of your responsibilities.

Saturn in 12th House

You are an intensely private person, who needs frequent seclusion and time out from the demands and pressures of life. You work at your best behind-the-scenes and can be involved with institutions, such as hospitals, universities or government departments. In general, you tend not to be overly concerned with the need for public recognition, preferring instead a quiet and simple life if possible. You may suffer from inexplicable fears and anxieties, and possibly at the hands of false friends or secret enemies. On occasion, you can literally feel confined or restricted.

A Twelfth House Saturn suggests that your career or area of responsibility in the world relates in some way to work in seclusion, or for the care or education of others - perhaps in social work, hospitals, prisons, universities, religion or the arts. Your nature is acquisitive, reserved and inclined to solitude, with a desire to work unpretentiously, unobserved, and live peacefully or alone. With this placing of Saturn you may experience negative inner pressures related to subconscious insecurity, secret sorrows, fear, loneliness and disappointment. You may at some stage suffer false accusations by secret enemies.

Saturn Quincunx Uranus (0°04' A)

You often feel tense and churned up inside, as you struggle between the urge to conform and the urge to assert your individuality. One side of you wants to be like everyone else while the other side cannot bear the thought of it. Also, when you feel the pressure for change building up within you, don't suppress it because you may cause yourself stress and even possible physical injury. For your own peace of mind you need to find a balance between these conflicting urges. You are quite rebellious and will buck against anyone or anything that restricts your freedom.

Saturn Quincunx Moon's North Node (1°58' S)

It is very likely that you'll establish unions with others of a wide-age difference to yourself. Older people play an important role in your early life. You are attracted to them for their knowledge, wisdom and experience. You have a sense of responsibility towards others, coupled with strong feelings of loyalty and duty. At times, other people's actions can sadden or depress you. And, in some cases, there are people who can oppress you and make you feel bitter and frustrated.

Saturn Trine Ceres (4°56' A)

You may be a single parent (or may have been raised by one), and therefore have an easy ability to combine parenting and career, and be quite successful at both. You can teach self-sufficiency as well as providing nurturing and security. You can take a balanced and practical approach to dealing with issues of parental absence. You are practical and supportive in your role as parent, and encourage responsibility, independence and self-worth.

Saturn Trine Vesta (0°17' A)

You are easily able to give practical expression to the ideals you hold most sacred, and through time and dedication you will likely become a teacher and authority within the framework of your chosen spiritual path. Your devotion is based on a foundation of self-discipline and perseverance, and the combination gains you much respect and eventually places you in the role of teacher/authority. You tend to be traditional in your beliefs and experience your spirituality within a historical context.

Saturn = Mars/Uranus (-1°24' A)

Intense frustration. Confronting challenges which test personal strength and stamina. Focusing willpower and energies to overcome difficult situations. Contending with obstructive and aggravating conditions. Thwarted plans and intentions. Blocked energy. You have aggressive tendencies; hostile actions. Severity. You have accident proneness.

Saturn = Venus/Ascendant (-0°25' A)

You have a shy and unassuming personality. Understated displays of love and affection. Difficulty establishing and maintaining intimate contact with others. Modesty and simplicity. Projecting an aloof or distant manner in social situations. You have a killjoy or party pooper. Contending with issues of control and distrust within love and sexual partnerships. Restrictive and separative influences.

Saturn = Mars/Moon's North Node (-0°23' A)

Consolidating relationships in order to achieve shared goals. Focused activity and disciplined teamwork. Controlling others or being controlled. Clashes of will and ego. Defensive and reactive inclinations within associations. Conflict within partnerships. Decisive separations. Shared problems and grievances.

Saturn = Mars/Midheaven (+0°24' S)

Persisting against the odds. Focused will and determination. You have accountability for actions taken and not taken. Contending with professional difficulties or worries. The necessity to reassess vocational aims and objectives. You have a compromised will. The loss of status and reputation through ill-considered actions. Having to concede defeat - to terminate a course of action. Sacrifices.

Uranus

Uranus Generational planet - The energies of Uranus are electric and crammed with change. Uranus is forward-looking. It balks at tradition, and celebrates originality and individuality. Uranus is associated with technology, innovation, discovery, and all that is progressive.

On the up side, Uranus is associated with enlightenment, progressiveness, objectivity, novelty, and ingenuity. Negative expression of Uranus is rebelliousness without a cause and irresponsibility.

When Uranus is not developed, it reacts; but when natives are truly in tune with its energies, Uranus is highly intuitive. It represents the spark of intuition that spurs invention. We can see Uranus as the intuition that sparks further studies or investigation.

In the chart, the position of Uranus by sign will be shared with other people in the same generation due to the comparatively slow movement of Uranus in the heavens. By house, the position of Uranus shows where individuals look to stir

things up, put a new spin on situations, and go against established thought or order. Uranus aspecting other planets in the chart color those energies with some willfulness, quirkiness, and originality. Where we find Uranus in the chart is where we see some refusal to blend in with others (and situations), and some erratic life pattern.

Uranus in Leo

You are a member of a generation that strives to be different and independent. You insist on individual freedom and will rebel against authority. Boldly enterprising, you will take risks. You can be obstinate, self-willed or uncompromising.

Uranus in 7th House

In your personal and professional relationships, you tend to be drawn to unusual people and are inclined to form unconventional unions. You appreciate individuality and originality in others. Partners may also be eccentric and a law unto themselves, which can be both stimulating and exasperating. Personal attachments are likely to be formed and terminated suddenly.

Uranus Conjunct Moon's North Node (2°02' A)

You either prefer the company of unusual and original people, or you come across to others as unconventional and eccentric yourself. You enjoy change and variety with regard to your associations and can be inclined to make and break contacts suddenly and unexpectedly. When meeting new people, you tend to assess their character intuitively and quickly. You may associate with people who expose you to unsettling or disruptive experiences.

Uranus Square Ceres (4°53' A)

You are likely to feel very conflicted over the issue of intimacy versus freedom. You need both, but it may seem you have to choose between them, which creates a dilemma resulting in great tension within close relationships. You may have a fear of commitment which limits your ability to maintain close, bonded relationships; or you may fear loss of intimacy if you pursue your need for spiritual exploration and individuation. Your idealism might lead you on a journey that involves separation from loved ones. It is possible (though not necessarily easy) to make room for both needs in your life, and if you manage it, this will result in stronger bonds.

Uranus Quincunx Pallas (0°53' S)

You may have lofty humanitarian ideals and work for social change, while also enjoying the privileges of social class, promoting the arts, education and social development. The

two areas of involvement have little or no connection or compatibility in your life. There seems to be a paradox or riddle you must solve and though you probably make many efforts to make a bridge between them, the results are not what you hoped for. Through your continued efforts you will clarify your own position and realize considerable personal growth and understanding.

Uranus BiQuintile Juno (0°37' S)

You have a great talent for forming relationships that promote and further creativity and expressions of individuality and freedom. Spiritual exploration and social reform are an integral part of the fabric of your partnership, and you are mutually supportive of each other's expansion of awareness and expression of ideals. You find or create methods and means that are original, resourceful and exciting. You might share excursions into alternate dimensions or experiences that transcend time. Your shared adventures and insights keep the relationship exciting and ever growing. You may be a guide or role model for others in creating relationships that encourage personal growth and expansion of awareness.

Uranus Square Vesta (0°14' A)

You feel conflicted over the need for freedom and unhampered exploration and the spiritual ideals you hold dear. A dilemma exists within your psyche over traditional, cherished beliefs and the free expression of individuality. Sexuality may be a core issue, with ideas of sacrifice and celibacy facing off with the need for radical freedom. You could easily become a fanatic, either strongly opposing any commitment to spiritual traditions or conversely being over-zealous in your attempts to convert others to your way of thinking. Intellect versus devotion may be a source of inner conflict, as are freedom versus commitment. It is very advisable to find a way to accept and allow room in your life for both needs, otherwise this dynamic is likely to be a source of much tension.

Uranus = Ascendant/Midheaven (-1°48' A)

Living in a constant state of excitability - or agitation. Individualistic tendencies. You have a highly independent and resourceful nature. Understanding and relying upon - the intuitive process. You have a constant need for freedom of movement and expression. Restlessness; high mobility. Unpredictability of self and circumstances. Contending with the unexpected in life - at a personal and professional level. Sudden adjustments and interventions. Interruptions and disruptions. Upsetting experiences. The tendency to 'stress out'.

Uranus = Mars/Saturn (-1°19' A)

Intense frustration. Coping under duress. Exposure to volatile, challenging and perilous influences. The state of being caught off-guard or suddenly disadvantaged. Defense and attack. Hostile actions; aggravating and debilitating circumstances. You have angst. Decisive separations. The experience of loss and grief.

Uranus = Sun/Pluto (-0°30' A d)

You have an extremely independent and self-willed individual. Self-exploration; discovering new frontiers of personal challenge. Channeling creative energy into pioneering ventures. Breaking new ground. The compulsion to reorganize personal circumstances. Manipulative influences. Defiance. Problems through extreme and erratic behavior.

Uranus = Moon/Ascendant (+0°26' S)

Responding instinctively and spontaneously to environmental influences. Changes of mood triggered by other people and situations. Thriving on external stimuli and sensation. Unpredictable and changeable personal relationships. Unexpected or unsettling experiences within the family or domestic scene.

Uranus = Mars/Jupiter (+1°27' S)

You have an intuitive sense of timing. Trusting own judgment - having faith in personal abilities. You have an entrepreneurial spirit. Successfully implementing new methods or techniques. Taking calculated risks. High motivation. Decisive action. Independent and ambitious initiatives. The desire to run one's own business or to act in a freelance capacity.

Neptune

Neptune Generational planet - Neptune is considered a planet of inspiration, dreams, psychic receptivity, illusion, and confusion. Neptune rules spirituality, and all things subtle. A youthful, and sometimes naive, spirit characterizes those with a strong placement of Neptune in their natal charts.

On the up side, Neptune is associated with intuition and spiritual enlightenment. As well, it is a planet of mercy and compassion. The more negative manifestations of Neptune include deception, trickery, deceit, guilt, and addiction.

In the chart, the position of Neptune by sign will be shared with other people in the same generation due to Neptune's slow movement in the heavens. By house, Neptune's position shows where intuition, dreams, and psychic sensitivity come into play. Natives may be able to rise above the demands of the ego in the areas of Neptune's influence.

Planets that Neptune contact are often colored by fantasy and dreaminess, and a vulnerable nature that may be susceptible to disillusionment. Here, we find hope that is sometimes unrealistic, a poetic and intuitive outlook, and compassion..

Neptune in Scorpio

You have an intense fascination with metaphysical subjects, coupled with an attraction to the mysterious or the forbidden. You desire a deep understanding of life. There is a possibility of extremist views regarding sexual desire and collective morality.

Neptune in 9th House

You may be attracted to the mystical and ritualistic aspects of spiritual teachings. As a seeker of truth, you may come to realize that ultimate truth is indefinable. You may become devoted to a spiritual leader at some point in your life; however you need to discriminate between true teachers and false prophets. You have to approach all legal matters cautiously, as there could exposure to fraud or dishonesty. Long-distance travel is likely.

Neptune in the Ninth House may indicate that your imaginative and spiritual potential will manifest in an ability to gain knowledge through intuitive and mystical channels. You possess a clairvoyant, psychic and highly inspirational nature and are likely to investigate psychic phenomena, religion, psychology, philosophy, spiritualism, astral projection and other profound subjects. An inner need for transcendental rebirth could dominate your life. At times you may experience ominous foreboding, strange dreams and negative emotional states.

Neptune Sextile Pluto (1°38' A)

Neptune and Pluto are the solar system's slowest moving planets; consequently aspects between them last for a great number of years and their effects are less personal than collective. Since 1940 and continuing until about 2040 they are in Sextile aspect to each other. The major effect of this is to accentuate spiritual awareness and development en masse. You are part of a generation that is intent on exploring and refining the inner aspect of life and consciousness itself. You will be aware of a universal interest in metaphysical subjects, clairvoyance and psychical research.

Neptune Trine Chiron (3°17' S)

You have a highly sensitive nature and are probably psychic, musically gifted and artistic. You are very attuned to non-visible realms of existence, and you have an easy ability to use your refined perceptions to understand and implement your self-healing. This awareness also enables you to help others facilitate their healing process and learn to become aware of non-physical dimensions. You are gentle and compassionate, and your artistic expressions are likely to be whimsical, ethereal and/or transcendent. Spiritually you tend to be a maverick, and your healing methods are probably natural and holistic rather than hi-tech.

Neptune = Saturn/Ascendant (-1°55' A)

You have appearing more composed and in control than the case may be - masking true feelings. Guarded behavior. The experience of being personally disadvantaged or undermined by others - or environmental influences. Victimization. Suffering in silence or in private. Seeking sanctuary and retreat. Spiritual disciplines. Disappointing and detrimental relationships. Being caught in a web of deception.

Neptune = Sun/Jupiter (-1°54' A d)

Believing that anything is possible in life - high hopes and wishes. The need to keep expectations in perspective. Spiritual, religious or metaphysical interests. Development of the inner life. You have a risk of misplaced confidence and trust. Potential health problems through over-indulgence. The weakening of vitality through the overuse of intoxicants and stimulants. Depleted finances; over expenditure.

Neptune = Sun/Mercury (-1°10' A)

Inspired thinking and activity. Creative vision. You have a highly developed imaginative sense - an interest in music, lyrics, photography, creative writing, etc. You have a mind searching for spiritual answers. The tendency to lack clarity, discrimination and mental focus. Clouded judgment. Delusional traits. You have a sensitive nervous system.

Neptune = Jupiter/Ascendant (+0°51' S)

The eternal optimist. You have an idealistic and buoyant nature. Having faith and trust in the future. Believing that anything is possible. Spiritual or religious leanings. Feeling 'out of luck' or let down by others. Uncertainty and unreliability within partnerships. Undermining influences within the environment. Unwise risks or dubious speculations.

Neptune = Mercury/Ascendant (+1°35' S d)

You have a receptive and perceptive nature. Sensitivity to the thoughts and ideas of others. Potential misconceptions; a tendency to misjudge others or situations. You have

a risk of accepting people at 'face value'. Difficulty keeping on top of things through disorganization or mismanagement. Unreliability and distrust within relationships.

Pluto

Pluto Generational planet - Pluto, God of the Underworld

The energies of Pluto are transforming. Pluto represents subconscious forces, ruling all that is "below the surface".

On the up side, Pluto is associated with renewal and rebirth. It represents endings and new beginnings, as well as spiritual growth and rebirth. Negative expression of Pluto is an obsessive desire for power and control and general destructiveness.

In the chart, the position of Pluto by sign will be shared with other people in the same generation due to the comparatively slow movement of Pluto, the outermost planet, in the heavens. By house, the position of Pluto shows where individuals search for truths and deeper meaning. This area of life may be associated with change, upheaval, power struggles, and issues of control. Pluto in aspect to other planets in the chart colors those energies with obsessive qualities, power struggles, the need to find deeper meanings, and willingness to explore and examine. Where we find Pluto in the chart is where we either seek change and transformation, or have it thrust upon us if we refuse to accept our deepest needs. If we fear Pluto's energies, or our "dark" side, destructiveness (both directed at ourselves or others) is a byproduct..

Pluto in Virgo

You are a member of a generation who experiences extraordinary pressures and upheavals in the areas of employment and health. You are exposed to transformations within the work and health sectors that occur outside of your own control. You witness breakthroughs in medical science, coupled with a rise of interest in alternative therapies.

Pluto in 7th House

Personal and professional relationships tend to be intense experiences for both yourself and partners. You have a tendency to push partnerships to the limit, and to place great emotional pressure and demands on others. Power struggles are likely in your relationships, and issues of dominance and manipulation may need to be addressed. Under certain conditions, there can be disputes with powerful adversaries.

With Pluto in the Seventh House opportunities for transforming or regenerating yourself may come through marriage, close personal

relationships or business partnerships. General well-being is dependent on intimate and fulfilling relationships. Success here depends on how responsible you are in your dealings with partners, psychological compatibility, co-operation and the ability to understanding the emotional needs of others. This is a good position for working with law and the legal system, and with the public, particularly indirectly as through the courts.

Pluto Opposition Chiron (1°40' S)

You have some very deep work to do around issues of loss, intimacy and personal power. It is likely that you experienced loss of or abandonment by your mother (or equivalent), and that wounding created in you an attraction/avoidance pattern with death and intimacy. You may flirt with death in an unconscious desire to transcend, transform and overcome the fear. Your journey involves deep, initiatory experiences that prompt you to claim your spirit power and heal yourself. In so doing you can become a powerful healer, shaman and spiritual midwife, but you must accept and own your power and face your "shadow".

Pluto = Mars/Ascendant (-1°40' A)

You have a pushy and demanding personality. You have asserting a powerful and at times aggressive influence. Using force or 'muscle' to get ahead in life. You have a competitive spirit; the desire to win at all cost. You have an uncompromising will - refusing to concede or back down. Coercion and manipulation. You have a risk of inciting negative reactions from others in the environment. Intense and dramatic partnerships. Power struggles.

Pluto = Sun/Venus (+0°11' S)

You have a passionate nature. Personal magnetism and charisma. Intensified emotions and desires. You have an overpowering physical and sexual attraction. The desire for commitment in love and in partnership - deep and meaningful relationships. Drama and intensity in love life. Difficulties through possessiveness and obsessiveness.

Moon's North Node

The Moon's North Node

They are not planetary bodies; rather, they are mathematical points.

The Nodes of the Moon represent points of personal karmic imbalance. The North Node represents the kinds of experiences that we must work to develop in order to work with our karma and to grow spiritually.

Moon's North Node in Leo

You demonstrate self-confidence and self-assuredness in the company of other people. You often assume the role of leader and organizer in group activities. Other people will look to you for guidance. You are socially active, fun-loving, entertaining, and like sharing in festive events and social occasions.

Moon's North Node in 7th House

Your karmic lesson in life is to experience and learn about relationships. Partnerships, both personal and professional, can feature strongly in your life.

There is a need to develop social awareness through close interpersonal relationships. Marriage/non-marriage may be an important feature. Your egocentric, individualist and loner approach to life will eventually change. The needs of others will be understood and accepted. Self-identity is found through co-operation and adaptation to social issues. Happiness is attained through the warmth of human relationships.

Moon's North Node = Moon/Ascendant (-1°36' A)

You have an emotionally caring and sensitive nature. Sensing and accommodating to the needs of others. Genuine hospitality. Involvement with women - and women's issues. Perceiving the mood of the environment; instinctively picking up on what others are feeling. Dependencies within partnerships. Female friendships.

Moon's North Node = Mars/Jupiter (-0°35' A)

Connecting with creative and highly motivated people. You have achieving the desired results in enterprises through combined effort and endeavor. Prosperous partnerships. Profitable and rewarding associations. Business activity; lucrative deals and investments with others. Fertile relationships.

Moon's North Node = Uranus/Midheaven (-0°13' A)

You have an assertive and at times volatile individual. Being intent on achieving personal and professional objectives - regardless of how it affects others. Clashes of will and intolerance within associations. Selfish motives and independent ambitions. Difficulties working and collaborating with others - a maverick. Strained relationships and family dynamics.

Moon's North Node = Mercury/Mars (+0°09' S d)

Lively and heated discussions with others. Brain-storming sessions within associations. Taking an active interest in people's opinions or points of view. Letting one's intentions be known. Irritability and intolerance within relationships. You have arguments and disagreements.

Moon's North Node = Pluto/Ascendant (+0°13' S)

You have a magnetic personality. Powerful attractions and connections. Intense and dynamic relationships. Connecting with influential and powerful people. Manipulating others or being manipulated. Karmic and fated relationships. Power struggles within the environment - and within partnerships.

Moon's North Node = Venus/Saturn (+1°15' S)

Contending with commitment issues in love. Making sincere sacrifices for loved ones. You have a loyal friend or companion. Difficulty establishing intimate relationships. Emotional and sexual restraint between partners. Despondency and jealousy. Separative influences.

Moon's South Node

The South Node represents those experiences and qualities that come naturally to us, that are over-developed, and that we tend to fall back on. The South Node can be a point of undoing unless we develop the North Node experiences and qualities. Thus, consciously working on these "life lessons" can bring us to increased happiness and fulfillment. If we over-emphasize and fall back on the qualities of our South Node, at the expense of developing our North Node, we may have a difficult time feeling personally successful.

Moon's South Node in Aquarius

You risk relationship problems if you have difficulties accommodating others' individuality, or if you exhibit socially isolating tendencies.

Moon's South Node in 1st House

With the Moon's South Node placed here, you experience difficulties expressing yourself and feeling satisfied with your life.

Vertex

The Vertex is the point where the Prime Vertical intersects the Ecliptic in the west. The opposite point, in the east is called the Antivertex. They represent the opening and closing of doors in our lives; where people arrive and leave, and events start and finish.

Vertex in Virgo

You are expected to become an individual and not just a member of the group, and to project your own emotions in a special relationship instead of maintaining emotional separation. People expect you to be responsible for teaching, working on an entertainment project, or dealing with young people or children. You also should acknowledge and accept your need for admiration.

In doing these things, you may become aware of your own individuality or creative expression. You give outer expression to the affectionate, creative side of your nature. You strengthen your own ego by helping other people to develop theirs, and you instill confidence and self-worth in those around you through your magnetism and dignity.

Not accomplishing these tasks may lead to a psychologically crippling ego-complex or create conflict within you. You could suffer from the same impersonal treatment you sometimes indulge in.

Chiron

Chiron Chiron is a comet with a unique and erratic orbit. In the natal chart, Chiron is symbolized by the "wounded healer". It represents our deepest wound, and our efforts to heal the wound. Chiron was named after the centaur in Greek mythology who was a healer and teacher who, ironically, could not heal himself.

Chiron in our natal charts points to where we have healing powers as the result of our own deep spiritual wounds. We may over-compensate in these areas of life. Chiron, as a wounded healer, first must face issues of low self-worth and feelings of inadequacy and learn to rise above these issues. Because the wound goes deep, and we may work hard to overcome the wound, healing powers are potent.

Chiron in Pisces

You will have difficulty gaining your own sense of individuality. You have an ability to feel others' pain and may need to detach and meditate. You may also suffer from your own deep and personal grief. You may work for or serve within a healing institution.

Chiron in 1st House

Chiron here can make you like a knight in shining armor, always ready to fight for the underdog. Usually, while you are doing this, you are neglecting yourself. You could also be a wise councilor (especially in health matters) but you seem to have trouble taking your own advice. A 1st house Chiron can be a gifted teacher, and, of course, you can teach others how to do something better than you can do it yourself. A neat trick to get around this: Give yourself advice as if you were someone else. Then maybe you will take it.

Chiron Opposition Zeus (2°04' A)

Your generation wants to change society but alternates between rebellion and feeling lost for an alternative. You may revert to opting out of the system. If you can learn to bring substance to your idealism you can create a brave new world.

Chiron Square Kronos (3°25' A)

Your generation works hard to use your power to right the wrongs you perceive in society. First you must learn to control that power in your own life.

Ceres

Ceres One of the largest asteroids. Ceres in the horoscope shows the early nurturing we received and how we nurture others. It also directly rules food and clothing. I have seen two cases of professional designers who had Ceres aspecting Pallas (which rules the ability to see patterns).

Ceres in the Signs shows our nurturing style and the types of things that make us feel nurtured.

Ceres in the Houses shows where we are most likely to express our nurturing side and also where we can best receive nurturing.

Ceres describes the ways in which we face the issues of self-worth and self-esteem, relationships to our parents and children, attachment, dependency, loss, separation, rejection, grief, sharing, work and productivity.

Ceres in Taurus

You feel cared for when loved ones give you a sense of stability and security. You like to be touched and stroked, and nurtured in practical ways. You also like to show others you care through practical means.

Ceres in 3rd House

Nurturing could have been provided for you by brothers and sisters, or even neighbors. Conversely, you could have been the one nurturing them. Your words tend to be nurturing. This could be a good placement for a therapist or counselor.

Pallas

Pallas One of the largest asteroids. Pallas can be interpreted as an indicator where we put our effort. Pallas in the natal chart indicates the nature of our ability to recognize and implement patterns, arrangements and rearrangements.

Pallas also describes how we face the issues of learning, creativity, the arts, politics, healing, alienation from relationships, competition, and the fears of success..

Pallas in Pisces

You have a meditative mind, the ability to merge in your mind with the universe. You desire to heal the world through words, and may be involved in some form of artistic expression.

Pallas in 1st House

Pallas here gives superior ability to see patterns and solve problems, especially if it is within eight degrees of the Ascendant and in the same sign.

Juno

Juno One of the largest asteroids. Juno in the horoscope gives a good indication of the kind of marriage partner that we need and will get. Not the partner we think we want (those are ruled by Venus and Mars), but the one we need and actually wind up with. Let's get things straight here before we go into the details about Juno in your horoscope. Venus and Mars show what we consider to be our ideal man or woman. The 5th house describes the type of people we tend to get

involved with romantically. The 7th house tells us the kind of person our first marriage partner will be (and the 9th house describes our 2nd marriage partner, if any). Juno works on a more fundamental level.

Juno describes the ways in which we face the issues of compatibility, receptivity to others, mutual sharing, trust, jealousy, possessiveness and power struggles..

Juno in Aries

You need freedom within your relationships and may become impatient if that is denied. If you do not express your own need for independence you may attract a dominant partner.

Juno in 2nd House

This is the house of money, possessions, and one's sense of self-worth. Marriage will likely bring an increase in the sense of self worth. you could also seek to get married to improve your sense of self worth, but of course that seldom works. In this case, you usually don't pick the best partner. you will tend to stay even in a bad marriage because divorce for them could be devastating. you could also marry for money or regard your marriage partner as a possession. On the other hand, you may literally be married to your possessions, spending most of your time accumulating more and more.

Vesta

Vesta One of the largest asteroids. Vesta's placement in the horoscope shows where and how we can be dedicated, where we can focus our energies to the greatest effect. But it also shows where, periodically, we have to withdraw and "recharge our batteries." If we don't, we will become drained, and even sick.

Vesta describes the ways in which we face the issues of personal integration, work, devotion, commitment, sacrifice, alienation from personal relationships, and a range of sexual complexes based on denial and fear of intimacy.

Vesta in Taurus

You have the ability to work in a stable and persistent manner. You are committed to working in a comfortable and predictable manner. You need to avoid becoming inflexible.

Vesta in 3rd House

To recharge, you have to clam up and stop communicating for a while. If you have brothers or sisters, you can't be around them continuously because you can drain you. You have to get away. Neighbors have the same effect, but since one is not usually around them 24 hours a day, this will be less of a problem.

Vulcan

Vulcan is more commonly used in the field of Esoteric Astrology. It has yet to be officially discovered and therefore its position is still open to speculation. Esoteric Astrologers believe that Vulcan is a powerful planet and will be discovered only when humanity is ready to use its tremendous power. It represents the power to smash or breakdown crystallized matter and form, to pave the way for the fusion of new forms. Its speculative position shows us where we need to break down the old in order to forge the ne.

Cupido

Cupido is one of the Trans-Neptunian Planets. It represents the arts and beauty, relationships, family, family history, marriage, and sociability.

It can symbolize one's personal family as well as one's business or corporate family (or more generally any organization, agency, or other social collective), and is frequently prominent at times of marriage..

Hades

Hades is one of the Trans-Neptunian Planets. Representing many of the more sordid or disagreeable sides of life, Hades is associated with waste, decay, illness, sorrow, and want -- as well as anything that is vulgar, crime-related, or crude. But it can also refer, without any unpleasant overtones, to antiques, ancient art, and other things from the distant past.

Doctors and others in the healing and helping professions often have links between Hades and the Ascendant, thus reflecting the needs and problems of their clients. Dr. Jonas Salk, the inventor of the Salk polio vaccine, has his natal

Hades (21 degrees Pisces) exactly trining the midpoint (21 degrees Scorpio) of his close Mercury-Mars ("walking," and other "motor skills") conjunction in Scorpio. On the other hand, the sextile present in film comedian Charlie Chaplin's chart between natal Hades (27 degrees Aquarius) and the natal Sun (27 degrees Aries) no doubt relates as much to his film image as the penniless tramp as it does to the poverty he experienced as a child..

Zeus

Zeus is one of the Trans-Neptunian Planets. It represents purposeful activity, enthusiasm, creative energy, machines, and weapons.

A symbol of "controlled energy," Zeus is linked to all types of creative and procreative endeavors. It has an active, fiery nature, and lends considerable zest and drive to whatever it touches. Machinery, weapons, and the combustion engine are all related to Zeus, as are production lines and leadership activities.

In combination with Kronos and Vulcanus, Zeus has been found to have strong ties to the weapons and destructive power of modern warfare, and all three planets were closely linked throughout the entire period of World War II. Zeus (16 degrees Leo) squared Kronos (16 degrees Taurus) at the start of the war (September 1, 1939), and (at 18 degrees Leo) was exactly sextile Vulcanus (18 degrees Gemini) during the bombing of Pearl Harbor (December 7, 1941). But Zeus's creative energy and focused drive normally finds more positive, less destructive, outlets in the natal chart -- through sports activities, for example. Professional football quarterback Joe Namuth has his natal Zeus (18 degrees Leo) sesquiquadrate natal Mars (3 degrees Aries), while jockey Robyn Smith as her natal Zeus (20 degrees Leo) semi-sextile natal Mars (20 degrees Virgo) and conjunct her natal Sun (21 degrees Leo)..

Kronos

Kronos is one of the Trans-Neptunian Planets. It represents authority, leadership, mastery, differences of opinion, and bureaucracy.

Bearing the Greek name for the original ruler of the gods (later known as Saturn to the Romans), Kronos symbolizes all figures of authority (both heads of state and heads of households), and anything that is similarly "superior," "high up," or "at the top." Issues of independence (being one's own boss), parenting

(becoming an authority figure in the family), and success (making it to the top of one's profession) are all Kronos-related concerns.

As the planet of kings, presidents, prime ministers, and corporate directors (especially in combination with the Sun), Kronos figures prominently in the charts of many top politicians and other people in high office. England's Queen Elizabeth has Kronos (6 degrees Taurus) widely conjunct her natal Sun (0 degrees Taurus) and exactly semi-square her natal Sun/Moon midpoint (21 degrees Gemini), while her eldest son, Prince Charles, has his Kronos (22 degrees Taurus) exactly opposite his natal Sun (22 degrees Scorpio). Ronald Reagan's progressed Sun was conjunct progressed Kronos when he was elected to the presidency in 1980, and transiting Kronos was conjunct George Bush's natal Sun during his term of office eight years later. But the influence of Kronos isn't restricted solely to the world of politics. Sun-Kronos contacts can describe the people who have risen to the top of a variety of professions, and combinations of these same two planets can also signify the proud parent..

Apollon

Apollon is one of the Trans-Neptunian Planets. It represents career opportunities, overseas connections, and multiple interests.

Apollon is that which indicates "a lot of" or "more than one" of anything. It has close connections with the worlds of commerce, science, and education, and can also symbolize success, expansion, and foreign countries.

As the planet of foreign lands and other "distant places" (especially in combination with the Ascendant or 0 degrees Aries), Apollon ought to be well positioned in the horoscope of Neil Armstrong, the first man to set foot on the Moon. And indeed, it is. Armstrong's natal Ascendant (18 degrees Gemini) falls exactly conjunct his 0 degrees Aries/Apollon midpoint (18 degrees Gemini). Apollon's associations with science and success can also be seen in the triple conjunction (at 0 degrees Libra) that was being formed by transiting Jupiter, Uranus, and Apollon at the time of the astronauts' historic lunar landing in 1969..

Admetos

Admetos is one of the Trans-Neptunian Planets. It represents delays, frustrations, complications, endurance and perseverance.

Solid and steady as a rock, Admetos is related to all that is stable, enduring, and unyielding, as well as to anything that has stopped or otherwise come to an end. Roots, raw materials, and cyclical revolutions all share a touch of Admetos, as does anything that is either deep down (like the bottom of the ocean) or dead. While Admetos, in combination with Saturn, represents being stuck (either physically or psychologically) in one of life's frustrating traffic jams, this planet of earthy substance and physical inertia also has close connections, as one might expect, with real estate and farming. Labor leader Cesar Chavez, who became head of the United Farm Workers of America, has natal Admetos (7 degrees Aries) widely conjunct his natal Sun (0 degrees Aries) and exactly trine natal Saturn (7 degrees Sagittarius), as seems fitting for someone whose career and father (the two are both symbolically linked to Saturn) were each involved with farm work. And in April 22, 1889, at the start of the Oklahoma land rush, not only were the Sun, Venus, and Mars appropriately located in earth sign of Taurus, but Venus (15 degrees Taurus), the ruler of that sign, was in turn exactly sextile Admetos (15 degrees Pisces)..

Poseidon

Poseidon is one of the Trans-Neptunian Planets. It represents spiritual influences, religion, ethics, and enlightenment.

Poseidon relates to all that is inspirational and spiritual, in contrast to that which is more practical or worldly. It is the planet of ideas and ideals, and is frequently associated with psychics, mystics, and mediums. Light and enlightenment are both symbolized by Poseidon, as are wisdom, knowledge, and places of religious worship.

Frequently identified with spiritual wisdom and psychic insights, inspirational Poseidon (0 degrees Virgo) is positioned exactly opposite Mercury (0 degrees Pisces) in astrologer Evangeline Adams' natal chart and, at 16 degrees Virgo, squares the natal Sun of astrologer Grant Lewi (16 degrees Gemini). In the horoscope of Peter Hurkos, the celebrated Dutch psychic, Poseidon (20 degrees Virgo) opposes Mars (20 degrees Pisces), sextiles Neptune (19 degrees Cancer) and trines his Sun/Mercury midpoint (19 degrees Taurus), while in the chart of religious leader and writer Jeddu Krishnamurti, the natal Sun (20 degrees Taurus) exactly sextiles his natal Mercury/Poseidon ("spiritual communications") midpoint at 20 degrees Cancer.

Part of Fortune

The Part of Fortune Sometimes called Fortuna, is the most popular Arabic Part. Arabic Parts are sensitive points in a chart, and are calculated using specific formulas whereby two planets or points are added together, and a third planet or point is subtracted from that result.

The Part of Fortune represents worldly success, and is associated with the physical body and health as well. It can be indicative of the career or vocation. The condition and placement of the ruling planet of the Part of Fortune (that is, the natural ruler of the sign in which the Part of Fortune is placed) is important to factor into the interpretation of this Arabic part. Worldly success and prosperity are associated with the Part of Fortune, and both its sign and house placement suggests innate abilities and talents--areas of life and qualities that are expressed naturally.

Part of Fortune in Aries

To find lasting happiness, you must always rediscover the world and your lust for adventure to admit, which does not always travel related. The everyday is claimed as exciting for you as possible and should be rich in variety, with not much rest can begin. Looking challenge where possible, as you describe your courage and your strength to prove. Personal success and awareness that you are successful on their own, at least for a short time will give you satisfaction. Then you will again set new tasks, particularly in areas that are represented by the house that happiness is about. Active, take action instead of making detailed plans, and spontaneity above all to enjoy - that are your conditions for happiness. Part of Fortune in 2nd House

You can be extremely lucky with money if it truly reflects a sincere value. Eventually you will develop an ability to see what is personally meaningful and necessary.

Black Moon

The Black Moon Lilith the black moon. Lilith is a strong gravitas force in our solar system. She can be tracked, but not seen. Lilith's position in our horoscope tells us about the suppressed shadow-side of our unconscious, and indicates things that are hidden in the shadows, unfulfilled wishes, painful experiences, privation and darkness. Nevertheless, Lilith not only brings death, pain and disaster, but also generates life.

Lilith is sinister & malevolent in her intent & ultimate effect so that the matters & people represented by the house she is in will not be granted full measure of the good that otherwise could develop in the native's life in that department. She is denying, frustrating & catastrophic bringing chaos to the affairs ruled by that house.

Lilith's brings temptation, seduction & betrayal that dishonor, if sufficiently afflictive. There is susceptibility to strange influences, delusions & fatal fascinations, infatuation & compulsion.

Black Moon in Leo

You have a strong attraction towards entertainment. People have no difficulty in persuading you to attend a party, where you like to place yourself on center stage. You also enjoy the odd game of chance, either by placing a bet or through speculations, even though your good sense tells you that it is best to keep well away from that type of activity. You know how to go about enticing people and manipulating them to your benefit, but all in all you are a creator of harmony and peace and are probably best known for your charm. Leo are very creative and expressive, they have an inborn erotic radiance. You can be very erotic. Most of the time people with Lilith in Leo were born in to a family where there are a few taboo's.

Alphard, (Alfard), is "the solitary star in the Water Serpent," the brightest star in Hydra. It is associated with poisons and 'poisoned thinking'. There can also be health risks through intoxicants and stimulants, and snake or insect bites. Nature is Venus and Saturn.

Moon's North Node conjunct Adhafera 0 25'

Adhafera is a star on the crest of the Lion's mane. A malefic star associated with danger from fire, explosives, acid or poison. Nature of Mercury and Saturn.

Moon's North Node conjunct Al Jabhah 0 46'

Al Jabhah is a star in the Lion's neck or mane. Brings loss and danger of violence, especially when rising. Nature of Mercury and Saturn.

Midheaven conjunct Rigel Kentaurus 0 45'

Rigel Kentaurus, in Centaurus, is the "foot of the centaur," sometimes called Toliman, "grapevine shoot." It has also been referred to as Bungula. Of the nature of Venus and Jupiter, it brings good fortune and rewarding connections. Well placed, it can help to gain a position of honour and power.
